BRING TO THE EXAM ROOM

- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for all multiple-choice answer sheets.
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free response questions in most exams.
- A watch (in case the exam room does not have a clock that can be easily seen).
- Social security number for identification purposes. This is optional. If provided, it will appear on your AP Grade reports.
- Up to two calculators with the necessary capabilities if you are taking an AP Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics Exam.
- A ruler or straightedge if you are taking an AP Physics Exam.

DO NOT BRING TO THE EXAM ROOM

- Cellular phones, pagers, personal digital assistants (PDA's) or any other electronic communication device
- Books, compasses, colored pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.
- Rulers and straightedges (except as previously noted)
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets).
- Computers (except as noted for students with disabilities), or calculators (except as previously noted).
- Watches that beep or have an alarm.
- Portable listening or recording devices even with headphones or photographic equipment.
- Food or drink.
- Clothing with subject related information.

CALCULATOR POLICY

A graphing calculator is necessary if you are taking the AP Calculus AB or Calculus BC Exam. A graphing calculator with statistical capabilities is expected if you are taking the AP Statistics Exam. A scientific or graphing calculator is permitted for parts of the AP Chemistry, Physics B and Physics C Exams.
