**The following is an outline of some student misbehaviors and the possible consequences for these actions. This list is not exhaustive. It is only meant to be used as a guideline by High School administration. Cumberland Valley High School administration reserves the right to deviate from this on a case-by-case basis.**

**Other consequences may be given in accordance with the guidelines in the student handbook and Board Policy.**

## **Allowing another person to use parking permit**

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 10 days
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 20 days
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: Parking privilege revoked

## **Failure to display parking permit**

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Verbal Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Warning
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: Permit suspension for 10 days

## **Failure to notify office if parking information changes**

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Permit suspension for 10 days

## **Having objects in car that are not permitted**

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Parking privilege revoked

## **Leaving School without permission**

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 10 days
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 20 days
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: Parking privilege revoked

## **Loitering in the parking lot**

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 10 days
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: Parking privilege revoked

## **Loss of parking permit**

- Replacement permits can be purchased for \$10

## **Parking in a spot other than the one assigned**

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 10 days

## **Parking on campus while permit is suspended**

- Student will automatically receive the next level of suspension of parking privileges (10 days, 20 days, revocation of parking privilege for the year)
- Vehicle may be towed at the owner's expense

## **Parking on campus w/out a valid parking permit**

- 1<sup>st</sup>: Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup>: Detention
- 3<sup>rd</sup>: Two detentions
- 4<sup>th</sup>: Suspension, possible trespass charges and vehicle may be towed at owner's expense

## **Tardiness to school**

- 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>: Warning
- 4<sup>th</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 10 days
- 7<sup>th</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 20 days
- 10<sup>th</sup>: Parking privilege revoked

## **Tobacco/E-Cigarette violation (use or possession in vehicle)**

- Parking privilege revoked

## **Unexcused absences to school**

- 4 - Warning
- 7 - Parking privilege suspended for 10 days
- 13 - Parking privilege suspended for 20 days
- 17 - Parking privilege revoked

## **Unsafe driving**

- Depending upon degree:
  - 1<sup>st</sup>: Warning
  - 2<sup>nd</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 10 days
  - 3<sup>rd</sup>: Parking privilege revoked(Possible police notification at each level.)

## **Violation of state or local driving laws**

- Depending upon degree:
  - 1<sup>st</sup>: Warning
  - 2<sup>nd</sup>: Parking privilege suspended for 10 days
  - 3<sup>rd</sup>: Parking privilege revoked(Possible police notification at each level.)

Note: If a student's parking permit is revoked, students will not be reimbursed for the cost of the permit.

## **FAQ –**

### **Q - Where do I park on the first day of school?**

**A –** Park in your designated parking spot. If you do not have a pass, you cannot park on campus.

### **Q - What if someone parks in my spot?**

**A –** Park in a visitor space and go into the 11/12<sup>th</sup> grade office and tell the secretary the situation and where you parked. Please do not park in someone else's spot.

### **Q - What if snow is piled in my space from the snow plow?**

**A –** Park in a visitor space and go into the 11/12 grade-level office and tell the secretary your situation and where you parked.

### **Q -What about days when the lot is being used for a district event and I can't use my spot?**

**A –** Rarely (usually one or two days a year), the parking lot will be utilized by others who are on campus for an event. During those times, announcements will be made in advance and you will be given instructions on alternative locations to park. It is possible that you may not be able to park on campus on those days.

### **Q – What if I get into trouble for speeding on campus?**

**A –** You will receive the District consequence for unsafe driving and you may be cited by the local authorities.

### **Q - What if I stop driving to school?**

**A -** Students who stop driving to school may not sell or give their parking space to another person. Possible reimbursement of the parking pass fee may be obtained through the grade-level office if a student decides to no longer drive to school.

### **Q - What if I lose/misplace my pass?**

**A -** If a student loses a pass, he/she forfeits the opportunity to park at school unless a replacement pass is purchased. There will be a \$10.00 replacement fee.

### **Q – Will I get any money reimbursed if my parking permit is suspended permanently for disciplinary reasons?**

**A –** No.

### **Q - How can I get a temporary parking permit?**

**A –** Visit the appropriate grade-level office and obtain a permit from the secretary. There is no cost for a one-day temporary parking permit.

### **Q – What happens after all of the permits for the Junior and Senior Lots are sold?**

**A –** There will be a waiting list for when additional spots become available. These spots may be in the main parking lot or in the Eagle View parking lot.
