Have you considered taking a BLENDED or SEMESTER III class?

Certain courses are taught in multiple formats. CV offers courses in a traditional format (class all 6 days of the cycle), blended format, and semester III.

Blended courses are designed for students who can work independently and enjoy selfdirected work. Blended courses meet face-to-face less than 6 days a cycle and include high amounts of online coursework.

Semester III courses are designed for students who are ready for a condensed schedule and are prepared to do 3-4 hours of homework each day. Semester III courses run from June 11 to July 27. Students will be in face-to-face class for 60 hours and will have at 60 hours of online work in the 6 week block.

To sign up for a Blended or Semester III course see the course numbers above. If you have questions, please see your school counselor.

Need help with your schedule?

Come to the IMC on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday of Course Selection Week (2/6-2/8) during any period. An administrator or counselor will be available to discuss your schedule and help you sign up for your courses on CVSIS.

How do students sign up for courses this year?

- 1. Between February 5 and February 14, go into the Student Portal of CVSIS. (<u>www.cvschools.org</u> > students > CVSIS. Your username & password are the same as your computer/Schoology login.)
 - a. Go into the Course Request tab of the portal (See ARROW #1 Below).
 - b. You should see course requests entered by your teachers. You do not need to enter duplicate course requests unless you want to take a BLENDED or SEMESTER III course. If you disagree with the teacher recommendation, please see the Counseling Center.
 - c. Enter elective courses and any other courses that you want to take next year.
 - i. To enter a new course request, click on the New Request button (See ARROW #2 Below).
 - 1. To delete a request, click on the delete icon (\times) .
 - 2. Click the Comments Icon (\bigcirc) to view and/or enter a comment.
